The Yarmouth Colts have again assembled a very strong staff of local and regional coaches, most returning year after year. Our camp directors, Rich Smith and Mike Hagerty, Yarmouth's girls' and boys' varsity coaches respectively, are returning for their 20th year. - Johnny Murphy: All-State & All-New England midfielder at Yarmouth High and present college standout at Bates.
- Luke Pierce: All-State, All-New England & Academic All-American midfielder at Yarmouth High and presently playing at Williams College.

Yarmouth High School alumni and upperclassmen will serve as assistant coaches. Many have played, are playing or will play college soccer.

The Colts' Challenge Program

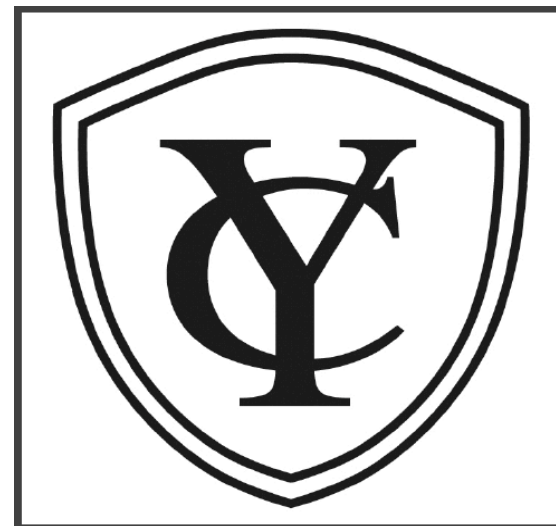
To help our oldest campers prepare for high school soccer, we have designed their week to be more intense. Their program includes:
